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CONSTRUCTION UPDATE 2020 STREET & UTILITY PROJECT

June 26, 2020

The 2020 Street & Utility Improvement project includes improvements on Scott Court from Central Avenue to the west, and 8th Avenue SE from TH 30 to south of Brian Court. Scott Court Improvements will include replacement of sanitary sewer and water pipes within the roadway, new service pipe to homes, installation of storm sewer, curb & gutter and roadway asphalt pavement. The improvements to 8th Avenue will include reconstruction of utilities within the roadway, new services to homes, storm sewer improvements, new curb & gutter and roadway asphalt pavement.

Construction will be temporarily paused on Scott Court throughout the week of 6/29/20. The contractor has completed all the utility work on Scott Court. The contractor will wait until all utility construction is complete on 8th Avenue and install the curb & gutter and asphalt pavement on both Scott Court and 8th Avenue at approximately the same time. **Scott Court will remain open to residential traffic.**

Construction will continue on 8th Avenue throughout the week of 6/29/20. The contractor has completed the sanitary sewer and watermain installation from the south end of 8th Avenue through Silver Street. The contractor has installed the water and sanitary sewer services to each residence (please note that a local contractor may need to complete the sanitary sewer installation from the Right-of-Way line up to the home).

During the week of 6/29/20, the contractor will complete the storm sewer installation on the southern portion of 8th Avenue. Upon completion of the storm sewer, the contractor will install sump pump lines which are installed at the location of the proposed curb & gutter at approximately 3.5' depth. These pipes will allow residents to discharge their sump pump lines below ground without discharging into the sanitary sewer system.

8th Avenue will remain closed from the south end of the project through Silver Street – residents should continue to park on the side streets to access their homes.

Residents will be kept up to date for the duration of construction with any changes in schedule or conflicts via these construction updates or door-to-door communication. Please note that rain or unforeseen circumstances could impact the contractor's schedule.
