CONSTRUCTION UPDATE 2020 STREET & UTILITY PROJECT

August 6, 2020

The 2020 Street & Utility Improvement project includes improvements on Scott Court from Central Avenue to the west, and 8th Avenue SE from TH 30 to south of Brian Court. Scott Court Improvements will include replacement of sanitary sewer and water pipes within the roadway, new service pipe to homes, installation of storm sewer, curb & gutter and roadway asphalt pavement. The improvements to 8th Avenue will include reconstruction of utilities within the roadway, new services to homes, storm sewer improvements, new curb & gutter and roadway asphalt pavement.

The contractor is scheduled to install asphalt pavement on Scott Court and 8th Avenue SE on Friday, 8/7/20. The contractor will install a 2" lift of asphalt pavement on 8/7/20, and a 1.5" lift of asphalt pavement in the summer of 2021.

Scott CT and 8th Avenue will remain closed to all traffic until the completion of the paving operation. Residents will be allowed to park on Scott Court and 8th Avenue on Saturday 8/8/20.

Residents of 8th Avenue will not be allowed to use their concrete driveway aprons until Tuesday, 8/11/20 to allow for adequate cure time for the concrete. Residents of Scott Court will be allowed to park on their concrete driveway aprons upon completion of the paving operation.

The asphalt contractor will be back early next week to complete the asphalt driveway patches as needed on 8th Avenue SE.

Please place your garbage and recycling receptacles at the end of your driveway by the end of the day today and the contractor will move the receptacles to a nearby side street for pickup.

Thank you for your patience during the roadway surfacing work!

Residents will be kept up to date for the duration of construction with any changes in schedule or conflicts via these construction updates or door-to-door communication. Please note that rain or unforeseen circumstances could impact the contractor's schedule.
