



# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## 2020 STREET & UTILITY PROJECT

April 27, 2020

The 2020 Street & Utility Improvement project will include improvements on Scott Court from Central Avenue to the west and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE from TH 30 to south of Brian Court. Improvements will include replacement of sanitary sewer and water pipes within the roadway, new service pipe to homes, installation of storm sewer, curb & gutter and roadway pavement. The improvements to 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue will also include reconstruction of utilities within the roadway, new services to homes, storm sewer improvements, new curb & gutter and roadway pavement.

**Construction is scheduled to begin on April 29, 2020 with installation of temporary water services on Scott Court.** This process will involve the contractor digging down to each home's water service line in the boulevard to hook up a temporary water line to supply water to each home while the new watermain is being installed in the street. This will not require the Contractor to enter homes.

Please note the following:

- The temporary water service pipe is laid on the ground along the front of the home. The pipe is plastic and approximately 2" in diameter. Please avoid damaging the temporary water service pipe with lawn mowers or other yard equipment
- Please monitor children and prevent them from entering the construction zone
- If you have an irrigation system or invisible dog fence, please notify construction personnel

Crews will also be removing trees that conflict with street and utility construction. Trees that are to be removed will be marked with a pink ribbon on Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup>.

Upon completion of the temporary water installation and tree removal. The contractor will begin installing new sanitary sewer and watermain on Scott Court.

Residents will be kept up to date for the duration of construction with any changes in schedule or conflicts via these construction updates or door-to-door communication.
